- It contracts its internal intercostal muscles, which reduces volume of thoracic cavity.
 (Reduced volume) increases pressure of air in thoracic cavity above that of atmosphere.
- 2 Reduces buoyancy so making diving easier/less energy consuming.
 - Reduces uptake of nitrogen into blood so reduces risk of the bends.
