- 1 a Reduction in / lower species diversity.
 - **b** Kill all / a wide(r) range of species.
 - So helpful / desirable / beneficial species are killed.
- 2 Domestic bee populations are (much) larger than wild populations / contain up to 60,000 individuals.

OR

Wild bee populations are significantly smaller than domestic bee populations.

(Random) risk of one individual becoming infected increases as population number increases [accept converse].

Individual-to-individual transmission is higher if population density is higher [accept converse].

- 1 They all carry the same DNA / have the same genome.
 - (Some) different genes are transcribed (in the two types of cell).
 - Leading to different proteins being translated.
- 2 Since it is polar, an ester molecule cannot pass between the phospholipid bilayer.
 - (An ester molecule) is able to diffuse through channel proteins in the surface membrane.

OR

(An ester molecule) is actively transported through a carrier protein in the surface membrane.
