We call **silent final consonant SFC** and we call **silent final -e SFE**.



Le -e final - Pratique

Even if the final -e is silent, it changes the overall pronunciation of adjectives in the feminine form. That's because the consonant is no longer silent.

Le son /i/ - Pratique



The letter -i- can make several different sounds in English.

Example: till /ee/ April /awl/ dive /ah-y/



/ee/

This can make difficult to remember how to pronounce the letter -i- in French.

In French, the letter -i- can only make a sound /ee/ like in 'till'.
