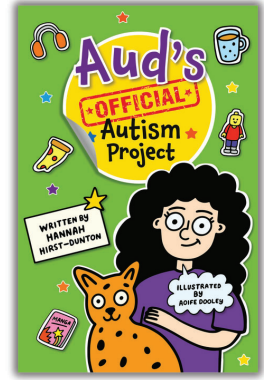


Aud's Autism Project

Questions:
